

'GRIZZLY ADAMS' STAR DAN HAGGERTY DIES AT 74

Los Angeles, CA (Friday, January 15, 2016) Famous '70s TV star **Dan Haggerty**-- who played Grizzly Adams -- died from cancer early Friday morning.

Haggerty died at St. John's Hospital in Burbank after battling cancer for the last five months. Doctors discovered the cancer after he had surgery for back pain.

Haggerty starred in the 1977 hit TV show "**The Life and Times of Grizzly Adams**" as the lovable mountain man whose BFF was a grizzly bear. He guest starred on several TV shows like "CHiPs" and "Charlie's Angels" and was a respected Animal Trainer and Prop Maker.

Dan was 74 years old and is survived by his 5 children, 2 grandchildren, 2 sisters and 3 brothers.
